

IGNITE 2019 INFORMATION LETTER



Congratulations on registering for IGNITE 2019. We're looking forward to five of the best days of summer (and one overnight).

The following information should help you prepare for the days you have registered.

Please keep an eye on JAC Youth on Facebook for the latest information and photos. We will try to maintain daily updates for you. You don't need to have a Facebook profile to view this page. Just Google JAC Youth and it will be high on the list.

Each student will receive a JAC Youth wristband on their first day. Please wear it each day of IGNITE 2019 as it will help us identify which youth are part of our group, especially at indoor climbing, Wet n Wild and Luna Park.

INFORMATION FOR DAY 1 – MONDAY 21st JANUARY

There will be a prayer time at 8.00am which anyone is welcome to attend.

The program itself begins at 8.30am (you should eat breakfast before you come).

After signing everyone in, we'll begin the day with some games.

Our session will be at 11am after Morning Tea. We look at the Gospel of Matthew this week and the parables Jesus told about the Kingdom of Heaven. In our first session we look at Matthew 13 and the parables about "The Growing Kingdom".

After lunch we'll head off to Sydney Indoor Climbing Gym at St.Peters.

This is a change in the advertised venue as Climffit in Kirrawee are not taking group bookings in the summer holidays, having just opened before Christmas.



The day finishes at 5.30pm back at the church.

Transport to and from Sydney Indoor Climbing Gym will be by car (No Red P drivers).

Where requested, youth will travel with full licensed drivers.

You will be provided with Morning Tea and Lunch.

Please keep an eye on the weather forecast for Day 1 so that you dress suitably.

Make sure you have the following gear with you:

- a hat
- a water bottle
- lots of suncream
- a Bible
- enclosed shoes (compulsory for the indoor climbing)
- a snack for afternoon tea

INFORMATION FOR DAY 2 – TUESDAY 22nd JANUARY

There will be a prayer time at 8.00am which anyone is welcome to attend.
The program itself begins at 8.30am (you should eat breakfast before you come).
After signing everyone in, we'll begin the day with our session at 8.45am.
We look at the Gospel of Matthew again and some parables Jesus told in chapter 13 about "The Priceless Kingdom".
We have Morning Tea after the session and then head off to Wet n Wild for the rest of the day.



The day finishes at 7.00pm back at the church.
Transport to and from Wet n Wild will be by car (No Red P drivers).
Where requested, youth will travel with full licensed drivers.
You will be provided with Morning Tea.

Please keep an eye on the weather forecast for Day 2 so that you dress suitably.
Make sure you have the following gear with you:

- a water bottle
- a rash shirt and swimmers
- a towel
- a hat
- a change of clothes
- lots of suncream
- a Bible
- a packed lunch
- some snacks for the afternoon

INFORMATION FOR DAY 3 – WEDNESDAY 23rd JANUARY

Today starts a little later with a prayer time at 9.30am which anyone is welcome to attend.
The program itself begins at 10am.
After signing everyone in, we'll begin the day with our session at 10.30am.
We look at the Gospel of Matthew again today and a parable Jesus told in chapter 20 about "The Generous Kingdom".
After Lunch we have our onsite Water Challenge with a mystery surprise!



The day finishes at 5.30pm.
You will be provided with Lunch and Afternoon Tea.

Please keep an eye on the weather forecast for Day 3 so that you dress suitably.

Make sure you have the following gear with you:

- a water bottle
- a rash shirt and swimmers
- a towel
- a hat
- a change of clothes
- lots of suncream
- a Bible

INFORMATION FOR DAY 4 – THURSDAY 24th JANUARY

There will be a prayer time at 8.00am which anyone is welcome to attend.

The program itself begins at 8.30am (you should eat breakfast before you come).

After signing everyone in, we'll begin the day with our session at 8.45am.

We look at the Gospel of Matthew again and a parable Jesus told in chapter 21 about "The Rejected Kingdom".

We have Morning Tea after the session and then head off to Luna Park for the rest of the day.



The day finishes at 5.30pm.

Transport to and from the Luna Park will be by train.

You will be provided with Morning Tea.

Please keep an eye on the weather forecast for Day 4 so that you dress suitably.

Make sure you have the following gear with you:

- a water bottle
- a hat
- enclosed shoes
- lots of suncream
- a Bible
- an Opal card (school student Opal cards will not work!)
- a packed lunch
- some snacks for the afternoon


INFORMATION FOR DAY 5 (DAYTIME) – FRIDAY 25th JANUARY

There will be a prayer time at 8.00am which anyone is welcome to attend.

The program itself begins at 8.30am (you should eat breakfast before you come).

After signing everyone in, we'll begin the day with our session. We look at the Gospel of Matthew again and a parable Jesus told in chapter 21 about "The Coming Kingdom".

After Morning Tea we'll head off for our Trek & Swim in either the Royal or Heathcote National Park. Many rate this as the best day of IGNITE each year.



The day finishes at 5.30pm.

Transport to and from the Trek & Swim will be by car (No Red P drivers).

Where requested, youth will travel with full licensed drivers.

You will be provided with Morning Tea.

Please keep an eye on the weather forecast for Day 5 so that you dress suitably.

Make sure you have the following gear with you:

- a water bottle (750ml minimum)
- comfortable walking shoes
- a rash shirt and swimmers
- a towel
- a hat
- a change of clothes
- lots of suncream
- a Bible
- lunch and snacks

INFORMATION FOR DAY 5 (O/NIGHT) – FRI 25th–SAT 26th JANUARY

The evening session will begin at 5.30pm with setting up of a tent city on the church lawn.

Dinner will be a barbecue at about 6pm with those extra family members who indicated that they would be attending when you were registered. We are expecting about 125 extra guests.

After dinner, we will go into the church for a short session that will include all the extra guests.

We say goodbye to our guests at 7.30pm and commence our Aussie theme night.

Supper will follow and then we'll head off to bed. There will be leaders on duty throughout the night. In the morning we will serve up a hot breakfast before packing up the tents.



The overnight finishes at 9.00am.

You will be provided with Dinner, Supper and Breakfast.

If the weather is inclement we will sleep in the church building rather than outside.

Make sure you have the following gear with you (can be brought at the start of the day):

- a tent (arrange to share with friends)
- a sleeping mat or air bed
- a sleeping bag
- a pillow
- pyjamas
- a change of clothes for Saturday
